Bystander Education & Training

The One Student bystander initiative offers an assortment of educational resources to help raise awareness and develop skills to reduce sexual violence; from public awareness campaigns and campus chapters to keynote programs, panel discussions and interactive curriculum based trainings for high school and college students.

Multi-Media Education

One Student offers an online clearing house of original educational resources to provide useful and timely tools for students and their allies including social norms campaigns, videos, print and digital posters, one-page resources, campus programs, the One Student podcast and social media outreach.

The YATO film is a great conversation starter that explores the role of students and social change in reducing sexual violence and addresses bystander intervention and supporting survivors. The YATO educational toolkit provides facilitators a guide to lead conversations that will help create a culture shift within communities.

Production Fellowship

Opportunity for talented students to amplify their voice through developing and producing original social norms campaigns. Fellows receive professional guidance, coaching, resources and a modest stipend. Completed works are distributed globally.

Campus Chapters

Campus chapters provide an opportunity for students to enhance their leadership skills and bring their community together to address important issues. Chapters receive new educational materials and resources, mentoring and opportunities to address and program on timely issues.

Collegiate Consortium

The Collegiate Consortium includes statewide college campus coalitions that provide education and leadership opportunities to help student board members organize their communities to address sexual violence and initiate a statewide movement for social change.
